Diving Championships (Turpin High School)

- Date:** Friday, February 2, 2007 (Diving @ Turpin)
Saturday February 3, 2007 (Swimming @ Mason)
- Times:** Diving: Warm-ups--- 4:00PM, Competition starts--- 5:00PM
Swimming: Warm-ups--- 10:30AM, Competition starts--- Noon
- Hosts:** Mason High School (Swimming), Turpin High School (Diving)
- Rules:** 2006/2007 NFHS will govern this meet. Admission: \$6/adults & \$3/students
- Entries:** Entries will be done using Hy-Tek Team Manager Software (see separate entry instructions). All times must be completed to the hundredth of a second. Each swimmer is limited to two (2) individual events and two (2) relays or one (1) individual event and three (3) relays. Each school is limited to four (4) individuals per event. Diving counts as one (1) event. Each school may enter two (2) relays per event. Coaches need to submit their entries for their relays as part of their Hy-Tek file. Relay changes can be made at the computer desk until 11AM. A scratch sheet will be available at the computer table and all scratches should be made before the coaches meeting starts.
- Diving:** Diving will consist of six (6) dives. "Reverse" will be the selected voluntary dive. All divers should have their dive sheets completed no later than 4:15PM with both their signature and their coach's signature. At that time we want the officials to be able to begin their cross-check of the diving forms. All diving entries (names of divers and the dive letter/number identification of their six dives) will need to be submitted to the meet Entry Chair with the swimming entries. This will allow us to create the diving order prior to the meet.
- Deadlines:** Entries must be emailed to the Entry Chair no later than 4PM, Saturday January 27, 2007. When you send in your entries to the Entry Chair, you will receive an entry report within 24 hours of the time your Hy-Tek file has been received. If you do not receive an entry report, assume that for whatever reason, your Hy-Tek file has not been received and contact the Entry Chair. A psyche sheet will be created and posted on the Mason team web site as well as the swimmeet.com web site. This psyche sheet will not be forwarded to the two web sites until all entries have been received. The psyche sheet will not be posted before 5PM on Monday evening to allow all coaches to review their entry report and make any changes. Once the psyche sheet is posted on the swimmeet.com website, no additional changes will be accepted to the individual entries.
- Scoring:** Each event will be scored through twelve (12) places. The scoring system is as follows: 16,13,12,11,10,9,7,5,4,3,2,1. For relays the point total doubles. The meet will be scored using three (3) divisions, Cardinal and Buckeye and Scarlet.
- Seeding:** All swimmers will be seeded according to entry times. Both divisions will be seeded together. A ten minute break will be scheduled after the 50 Freestyle. Other breaks may be added if requested at the coach's meeting.

Timers: Each team is required to provide one timer to work this meet. Each team is responsible for providing a relief person for their timer. Timers should report to the head timer for their lane assignments by at least 11:25 AM.

Cardinal: Amelia, Kings, Little Miami, Turpin, Wilmington, Walnut Hills .
Scarlet: Talawanda, Northwest, Ross, Edgewood, Norwood, Mt. Healthy.

Note: Check the optional dive for the week of the competition (Reverse may not be the correct dive next year). When doing the timeline, use a 30 second delay between heats. Add a ten minute break after the 50 Free event. Schedule a coach's meeting 30 minutes before the meet starts. The officials meeting should follow immediately after. Timers meeting will be held immediately before the meet starts (ref has option of dismissing the starter early to hold the timers meeting). Make 250 copies of the meet program for sales. Make coach's package with two copies of the meet program, warm-up lane assignments, copy of this information letter and relay cards/sheets and the swimmer/coach of the year ballots. Have the computer desk run an entry report after the relay entries are entered to confirm that no team has exceeded its limit of entries.
